# Cobdogla Primary School Behaviour Management Plan

## Low to medium behaviour Concern

- Impolite manners/rudeness towards others.
- Intruding on other's personal space.
- Negative comments towards others.
- Littering.
- Misuse or lack of proper care of property.
- Showing minimal effort or care in learning.
- Disruptive behaviour in class.
- Not following instructions.
- Not keeping on task.
- Running on concrete/inside buildings.
- Rough play.
- Not sitting on chairs properly.
- Playing in Out-of-Bounds areas.
- Being dishonest.

#### Med-High Behaviour Concern

- Persistent negative attitude/ rudeness.
- Intentional high level swearing.
- Harassment,/bullying/teasing.
- Fighting,/hitting people.
- Speaking inappropriately to adults.
- Not following reasonable requests.
- Vandalism/damage to property
- Stealing.
- Continuous disruptive behaviour.
- Refusal to do set tasks.
- Dangerous play- throwing sticks, rocks, or purposeful injury
- Leaving school grounds.
- Serious lying or dishonesty.

## \*NOTE\*

In the case of <u>sudden or</u>
<u>extreme violence</u>, the
student will be placed on
an **immediate Take Home**to ensure the safety and
wellbeing of all.

#### Step 1: Reminder of Class/School Rule



### Step 2: Official Warning

Behaviour recorded in class Behaviour Book.



## Step 3: Play/Buddy Sit-Out

Student to sit out of play for 10mins in the next break, OR to sit-out in buddy class for remainder of the lesson.

(Yellow 'Sit-Out' form completed and sent home via communication book)



#### Step 4: Office Time Out

Student to sit out in the office for extended period of time, and complete Behaviour Plan.

(Behaviour Plan and red 'Oficce Time-Out' sent home via communication book)

NOTE: If a student receives 3 Red Consequence Slips in a term, parents/carers will be required to attend a meeting and the student will be placed on a Behaviour Response Plan.



#### Take home

When above strategies have not improved the behaviour, the Parent/Carer will be phoned and asked to take the student home for the remainder of the day.



Principal to meet with Parents/Carers to discuss appropriate Behaviour Response Plan, which may include:



Student to work in the front office under Principal's supervision, and will have modified play breaks.

## Home Suspension

Student externally suspended for up to 5 days.

NOTE: Student can only return to school after a re-entry meeting has taken place.

#### **Exclusion**

Student excluded from school for 4 to 10 weeks.

<u>NOTE:</u> will involve Regional Services.
