
Buddies

The students began by meeting their buddy and creating a Venn Diagram about themselves. One side of the diagram shows facts about the big buddy and the other side shows facts about the little buddy. The middle of the diagram, where the circles overlap, shows the similarities of the big and little buddies. As an example, if both the big and little buddy loved playing cricket, then they added this to the middle of their diagram. The students then turned their diagram into mini versions of themselves using lots of creativity and coloured paper.


